

Jerusalem's Walls & Gates


In the days of Nehemiah (Nehemiah Chapter 3)

East Gate (aka Golden Gate or Beautiful Gate)
Jesus entered Jerusalem on Palm Sunday through this gate Matthew 21, Mark 11, Luke 19, and John 12. Prophetically, Jesus shall return and enter: Ezekiel 10:18-19; 11:23; and 43:1-5. Sealed shut in AD 1540-41 by order of Suleiman the Magnificent of the Ottoman Empire.

"And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and he that sat upon him was called Faithful and True..." (Revelation 19:11 KJV)
